what is ReStore salvage service?

ReStore Salvage Service is a program of Habitat for Humanity of the Chesapeake. We work with local contractors and homeowners to salvage easily removed items like cabinetry, sinks, doors, windows and more from homes undergoing major renovations. Salvaged materials are sent to Habitat Chesapeake's ReStores – retail outlets that sell new and gently used building materials, furniture, housewares, and more at discount prices. Profits from ReStores support Habitat's mission to build affordable homes for hardworking families throughout Central Maryland.



how does it work?

1. Call the ReStore donation hotline at 410-633-0506 or email RestoreSalvageService@habitatchesapeake.org to schedule a consultation
2. A ReStore Salvage Service representative inspects the home to assess whether the project falls in our scope of service*
3. We carefully remove cabinets, sinks, appliances, windows, doors and other saleable items
4. We leave your site clean and ready for the next phase of your project
5. You receive a donation receipt. ReStore donations are tax deductible to the full extent of the law

Please note: Habitat for Humanity of the Chesapeake reserves the right to accept or refuse a salvage opportunity for reasons including, but not limited to: size of property, volume and/or condition of materials to be salvaged, time limitations, etc.

what items are we looking for?

We work closely with your team to identify any and all items that we believe are easily removed from the home and in good, saleable condition.

These may include:

- Kitchen and bathroom cabinets
- Sinks and toilets
- Appliances
- Lighting fixtures
- Doors and windows
- Furniture and housewares

We aim to work in homes undergoing major renovations. For limited home remodeling projects, we advise that the contractor and/or homeowner remove salvageable items themselves and call ReStore at 410-633-0506 to schedule a free pick up.
