- **Houses For Change** - Construct house-shaped banks and collect money for Habitat Chesapeake.

- **Host a ReStore Donation Drive** - Choose a day for families to drop unwanted furniture, appliances, housewares, lighting and/or flooring at your location and a ReStore representative will pick them up!

- Attend a Habitat Chesapeake home dedication
- Participate in a ReStore DIY contest
- Clean up a construction site before a dedication

* Habitat Chesapeake requires volunteers to be at least 18 years of age or 16 with an adult chaperone (1:10) to work on a construction site and 16 or over to volunteer with the Chesapeake ReStore or 14 with an adult chaperone.
