About Habitat Chesapeake

Over the past 35 years, Habitat for Humanity of the Chesapeake has built or renovated more than 740 homes throughout Central Maryland, providing 2,500+ children and families with safety, stability and a brighter future. In 2017 alone, Habitat Chesapeake worked on 25 homes, helping 19 hardworking families become homeowners.

About HabiCorps

HabiCorps prepares individuals facing significant employment barriers for full-time jobs in construction trades. Trainees are AmeriCorps service members that serve 1700 hours building affordable housing for low income families with Habitat Chesapeake. While serving the community, Trainees are also perfecting construction and carpentry, hard work, punctuality and attendance. Upon completion of the program, Trainees receive an education award as well as job placement assistance.

How It Works

Recruitment

HabiCorps team members are recruited from feeder programs, like Job Opportunities Task Force's (JOTF) Project JumpStart, which introduces participants to construction trades and fosters overall job readiness. Approximately 25% of JOTF graduates need more training and time before they can be successfully placed in the construction field. HabiCorps bridges the gap, ensuring that no one is left behind on the road to workforce readiness.

Training

HabiCorps trainees work in small teams alongside experienced instructors, rehabbing and building homes for low-income families. The projects vary greatly, from new construction to complete renovation of existing buildings. As a result, HabiCorps trainees experience everything from framing to fine carpentry. Along with real-world construction experience, HabiCorps team members receive financial literacy coaching, case management services and free tax preparation from Habitat and our partners.

Job Placement

Through partnerships with feeder programs like the Job Opportunities Task Force's Project JumpStart, in concert with Associated Builders & Contractors, all HabiCorps graduates receive post-program job placement and assistance.
