what is ReStore salvage service?

ReStore Salvage Service is a program of Habitat for Humanity of the Chesapeake. We work with local contractors and homeowners to salvage and remove items like cabinetry, sinks, doors, windows and more from homes undergoing major renovations. Salvaged materials are sent to Habitat for Humanity of the Chesapeake ReStores – retail outlets that sell new and gently used building materials, furniture, housewares, and more at discount prices. Profits from ReStores support Habitat’s mission to provide affordable homeownership opportunities to hardworking individuals and families throughout Central Maryland.



how does it work?

1. Schedule a consultation! Email vwagner@habitat Chesapeake.org set up a time.
2. A ReStore Salvage Service representative will inspect your space to assess the scope of your project.*
3. We carefully remove cabinets, countertops, sinks, appliances, windows, doors, and other items per your consultation.
4. We leave your site clean and ready for the next phase of your project.
5. You receive a donation receipt. ReStore donations 100% are tax deductible.

Please note: Habitat for Humanity of the Chesapeake reserves the right to accept or refuse a salvage opportunity for reasons including, but not limited to: size of property, volume and/or condition of materials to be salvaged, time limitations, etc.

what items are we looking for?

We work closely with your team to identify any and all items that we believe are easily removed from the home and in good, saleable condition.

These may include:

- Kitchen and bathroom cabinets
- Sinks and toilets
- Appliances
- Light fixtures
- Doors and windows
- Furniture and housewares

The ReStore Salvage Service is best fit for homes or offices undergoing major renovations.
